



ICC Men's T20 World Cup Australia 2022 (T20WC)

Ticket Limit Policy

Effective 21 January 2022

The following Ticket Limit Policy applies in respect of tickets purchased to all ICC Men's T20 World Cup Australia 2022 Matches.

When purchasing tickets for the Event, you, as a Ticket Holder, will be limited to the specified number of tickets listed below.

EVENT

MATCH	TICKET LIMIT
First Round/Super 12	Ten (10) maximum
Semi-Final	Eight (8) maximum
Final	Eight (8) maximum

Should warm-up Matches be available to purchase, you will be able to purchase up to a maximum of ten (**10**) tickets per Match.

The maximum number of Matches in which tickets can be purchased is ten (**10**). In addition, an Event-wide ticket limit of 96 tickets per person will be imposed.

**Warm up matches do not count towards the number of matches a customer can purchase.*

If you exceed the stated ticket limit, you may have any or all of your orders and tickets associated with the Event cancelled without notice by the LOC or IBC at its discretion. This includes orders associated with the same name, e-mail address, billing address, credit card number or other information. The LOC and IBC reserve the right to apply different ticket limits during different sales phases, including any sales phases to venue members or other priority groups and to permit persons to purchase tickets more than the above limits.

Ticket limits apply to ensure fair access to tickets for fans and as a measure to minimise ticket scalping.

DEFINITIONS

KEY TERM	DEFINITION
Event	Refers to the ICC Men's T20 World Cup Australia 2022.
IBC	Refers to the ICC Business Corporation FZ LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of the ICC incorporated to exploit the commercial rights to ICC events, being a company incorporated under the regulations of the Dubai Creative Clusters Authority with its registered address at Office No. 28, Second Floor, Building 2, Dubai Media City, United Arab Emirates, and having its administrative office at Street 69, Dubai Sports City, Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Road, PO Box 500070, Dubai, United Arab Emirates.
LOC	Refers to the T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd (a company incorporated in Australia (ABN:14 618 113 269)), which has been appointed as the Local Organising Committee for the Event by Cricket Australia.
Match	Refers to a T20WC match (or matches, where two such matches are played in the same Venue on the same day) forming part of the Event or any other cricket match played as part of the official warm-up phase of the Event, the particulars of which are indicated on the Ticket;
Ticket Holder	Refers to any individual purchasing, possessing, holding or using a Ticket, including (without limitation) the Ticket Purchaser, Ticket Account Holder or any person to whom a Ticket has been issued or transferred.
